Frequently Asked Questions & Policies*

When does the Fall Travel season start?

The season usually starts in September and ends in October with no games played on Columbus Day weekend. There will be a game played on Labor Day weekend.

When do Fall Travel teams play games?

Games are typically scheduled by South Shore Soccer League to be played on Saturdays in Abington and in surrounding towns.

When do Fall Travel teams practice?

Players will be expected to attend at least one travel team practice per week as set by the volunteer coach and/or any grade group practices offered.

How much will Fall Travel cost?

FEES: Fees have not been set by SSSL. UNIFORMS: Travel uniforms will be required, approximate cost is \$50.00.

If you are experiencing a financial hardship, you must submit a Financial Hardship application. Please see www.abingtonsoccer.com.

If my player cannot attend a tryout because of an injury, etc., what should I do?

You must email ayspres@gmail as soon as possible to let us know of any recent injuries along with a doctor's note <u>PRIOR</u> to tryouts.

Must my player participate in the Fall Rec program to play in the Fall Travel program?

No. If selected to play on a Fall Travel team, you may participate in the Fall Rec Program. If you play both programs, be aware there could be schedule conflicts between AYS and SSSL on occasion. The schedule is set by SSSL right before their season starts so we do our best to adjust.

Must my player participate in the Fall Rec and/or Fall Travel program to play in the Spring Travel program?

No, but we encourage players to play in both programs!

How will I know my player was offered a spot on the travel team?

All players will be sent an email notification. You will have (2) weeks to register online to accept your team spot. If you do not register by this deadline, your player loses their spot and we will move to the next player on the wait list.

Please only accept a position on the team if you are able to make the commitment. There will be limited positions for this program and we strive to keep as many kids playing as possible! If a player decides they are not playing at the last minute, we might have had room for another player on the wait list but are not able to adjust rosters after deadlines. Please discuss commitments with your player. We appreciate your aid in our efforts!
