Grade 1/2 Rules Overview

- 1. No jewelry except for properly secured Medical tags shall be allowed. Taping over earrings is not allowed.
- 2. A player may not wear any casts in games or scrimmages, even if wrapped and/or given approval by a doctor.
- 3. All players shall wear shin guards. Shin guards must be covered by socks.
- 4. Cleats are highly recommended, but not required. Cleats shall conform to FIFA regulations and shall not have exposed metal or a spike on the toe.
- 5. Heading the ball is no allowed for any players in Grade 5/6 and below. Heading the ball during a game will result an indirect kick for the opposing team.
- 6. Grade 1/2 and below will not have throw ins. Any ball played out over the side lines will result in a free kick for the opposing team.
- 7. Grade 1/2 and below will not have corner kicks. Any ball played out over the end lines will result in a goal kick for the defending team.
- 8. For Grade 3/4 and below, at the taking of a goal kick all defending players must be no closer than the midfield line until the kick is taken by the offensive player.
- 9. There are no offsides for Grade 3/4 and below, however coaches should not allow their players to constantly play in an obvious offside position for the purpose of trying create easy scoring chances ("cherry picking").
- 10. No overtime is played during the Fall Recreational season.
- 11. Substitutions will be unlimited, and may be made as needed during the any stoppage of the game.
