Frequently Asked Questions & Policies*

When does the Spring Travel season start?

The season begins the first weekend of April and ends the first weekend of June. Any playoff games, etc. extend beyond this date.

When do Spring Travel teams play games?

Games are typically scheduled by South Shore Soccer League to be played on Saturdays and Sundays with the option to play other days in the case of a rescheduled game.

What are player expectations before the Spring Travel season starts?

- > Attend any professional team practices during the months of February & March.
- Attend at least one coach led team practice per week. Coach led team practice days and times would be set by the volunteer coach.
- Attend any indoor winter leagues. This is optional for each team and would be determined by your volunteer coach.

How much will Spring Travel cost?

FEES: Fees have not been set by SSSL. Any indoor winter leagues will be an additional amount outside of registration costs if your team participates.

If you are experiencing a financial hardship, you must submit a Financial Hardship application <u>WITH</u> pre- registration. Please see www.abingtonsoccer.com.

If my player cannot attend a tryout because of an injury, etc., what should I do? You must email ayspres@gmail *as soon as possible* to let us know of any recent injuries along with a doctor's note <u>PRIOR</u> to tryouts.

Must my player participate in the Fall Rec and/or Fall Travel program to play in the Spring Travel program?

No, but we encourage players to play in both programs!

How will I know my player was offered a spot on the travel team?

- > Your player will be sent an email notification of their status.
- > YOU MUST ACCEPT YOUR PLAYER SPOT BY REGISTERING BY THE DUE DATE!
- If you do not register by this deadline, your player will lose their spot & we will move to the next player on the waiting list. We do have waitlists and a SSSL deadline we must comply with.

Please only accept a position on the team if you are able to make the commitment.

There will be limited positions for this program and we strive to keep as many kids playing as possible! If a player decides they are not playing at the last minute, we might have had room for another player on the wait list but are not able to adjust rosters after deadlines. Please discuss commitments with your player. We appreciate your aid in our efforts!
